ASIAN ART IN DALLAS & FORT WORTH *with Dr. Emily Sano*

November 10 - 15, 2014



Please join the Society for Asian Art for five days in Dallas with Dr. Emily Sano, former Director of the Asian Art Museum. The big D in Texas is big into art and there is lots of it to see. Dr. Sano will guide us through the many museums in the Dallas/Fort Worth area including “behind the scenes” explorations. Highlights include:

- Viewing the Asian collections of the Dallas Museum of Art with their acclaimed curator of Ancient and Asian art, Dr. Anne Bromberg. Additionally, we have been granted access to view pieces from the Museum’s recently received gifts of Islamic art which are not currently on view to the general public.
- Touring Fort Worth’s architecturally noteworthy Louis Kahn designed Kimbell Art Museum and its Pavilion by Renzo Piano to see the Asian art collection. Here we will meet with Jennifer Casler, the curator of Asian art, for a special tour of the storage area.
- Conversing with famed author, consultant and collector of Indonesian textiles, Steven G. Alpert, who will not only lead us through the Indonesian collection at the Dallas Museum of Art, but has also invited us to his home to see his private collection.

The former Director of the Asian Art Museum Director, Dr. Emily Sano is also well known to Museum supporters as the personal art curator for Oracle chief Larry Ellison, and the consultant for the Asian Art Museum’s recent and much lauded exhibition, *In the Moment, Japanese Art from the Larry Ellison Collection*. She previously held curatorial and deputy director posts at the Dallas Museum of Art and at the Kimbell Art Museum.
